



Outdoor Cooking Skills

An Outdoor Cooking Skills day is being held at Sandy Lake Beach (Site 3) on Saturday, April 27th, 2019. Cost is \$25 plus GST. Deadline to register is **April 12, 2019** at noon.

This course is for Edmonton Area Guiders and Rangers only. You will see samples of several types of cooking equipment, plus prepare several dishes exploring charcoal cooking (dutch ovens, roasters, foil cooking), open fire (stick cooking, pie irons, grills), tin can cooking (camp bread, buddy burners/ vagabond stoves) and camp stoves. Experienced campers will share tips and tricks for success. Handouts will be prepared with all program content of the day.

Area Council has graciously provided you with a bus to take you to camp! The bus will depart at the southeast corner of Westmount Shopping Center at 8:30 am, arriving to camp at 9:30 am. (Breakfast will be ready!) The bus will depart camp at 4:00 pm, arriving back at Westmount for 5:00 pm. Those driving up to camp should carpool, as parking is limited.
