Archery is a sport open to all guides, pathfinders, and rangers in Edmonton Area. Archery improves mental fitness, flexibility, patience, discipline, improves self-confidence and attention skills. It is enjoyable indoors or out and offers instant personal success. Archery teaches everyone to be responsible for themselves, for one another, and for the equipment they are using.

The archery program began in 2006, when the first QAL course was held, and the girls have enjoyed the sport since, thanks to our dedicated Archery Leaders.

Archery Leaders are needed to assist in leading ranges, to help maintain and repair the equipment as needed, and to participate in promoting the program.

This comprehensive weekend will give you the skills to run a safe range, including equipment use and repair, 10 steps of archery, archery games, coaching and risk management, as well as personal archery skills. As a follow up, upon completion of the course, the Archery Leader will be required to run two ranges for the girls before earning qualification status.
